Dear Parents and Carers,

**After School Club Opportunity – Fridays 3.30-4.30pm (Year 5 & 6 boys)**

Solent Junior School is excited to announce the continuation of a very popular after school club being offered to Upper School boys. Thirty children will have the opportunity to go and train at Havant and Waterlooville Football Club with the club's schools football coach. They will be focusing on football fun and skills and will have the opportunity to train on the new 3G pitch!

The club will be running from Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September until Friday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023 (not including October half term and INSET Day on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> November). Every Friday after school, 15 children will be driven in the school minibus to the venue, so that they are ready to start the club at 3.30pm the next 15 children will be allocated a place at the club but will need to be taken to the venue by a parent/carer. The club will run for an hour, finishing at 4.30pm. At 4.30pm, all parents/carers will need to collect their child from the football ground, there will be no minibus transport back to school. The cost to attend this club for the spring term is £30 for the full 10 weeks. To book your child a place, please [click here](#) by **12noon on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023**. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. The first 15 children to sign up will be allocated a space on the minibus, the next 15 children will be allocated a place at the club but will need to be taken to the venue by a parent/carer. A waiting list will also be held. Signing up via the JotForm does not confirm your space, a member of staff will be in contact with you, via email, after the deadline to confirm if you have a place or have been added to the waiting list. Once the place is offered you will need to make payment in cash no later than Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September to confirm, if payment is not received by the deadline your child's place will be offered to a child from the waiting list.

**Absence/cancellation:**

You child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. Therefore, **it is vital that you telephone the school office by 1:30pm if your child is unable to attend on that day**. Please note, repeated failure to advise of your child's absence could compromise your child's place on the club. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation. Should the club need to be cancelled, due to weather, then you will receive a message by 1.30pm on that day.
